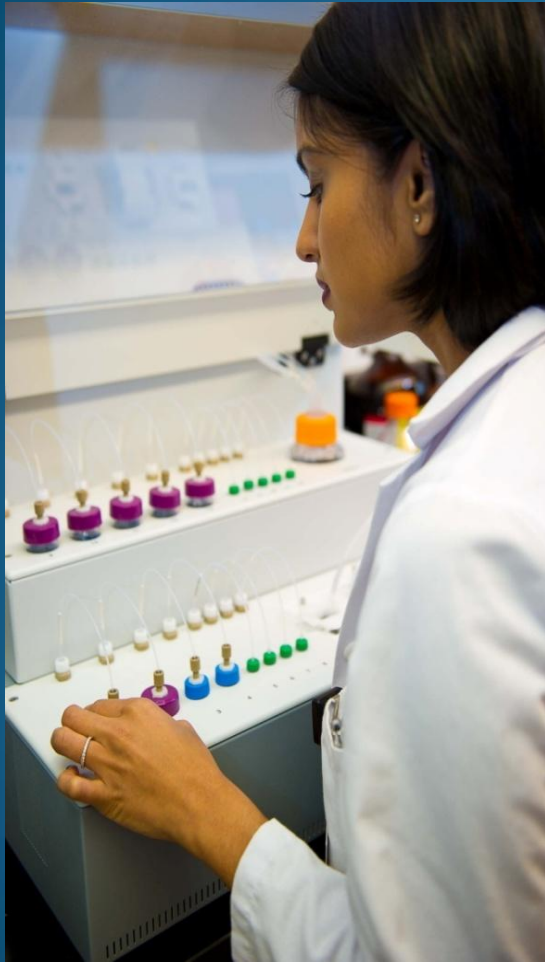
# Department of Medicine (PO) Work Relative Value Units
